Fecc is proud and honored to support the next EU Agency for Occupational Safety and Health (EU-OSHA) Healthy Workplaces Campaign as official campaign partner once again. For this campaign, Fecc will in particular raise awareness for potential opportunities and risks of digital technologies on the safety and health at the workplace of workers & employees.

The new campaign, which carries the title 'Safe and Healthy Work in the Digital Age', runs from 2023 to 2025 and foresees five priority areas:

- Digital platform work
- Remote and hybrid work
- Smart digital systems
- Worker management through AI
- Automation of tasks

The risks deriving from digitalization in the workplace fall within the scope of [Directive 89/391/EEC - the OSH framework directive](#), and the national legislations that transposed it into law.

For the chemical distribution sector in Europe, safety of workers and employees and enhancing health and safety in the workplace is a key priority. Fecc has long contributed to the ongoing improvement of worker safety issues through a combination of voluntary initiatives, such as Responsible Care.
